Here is a sampling of our activities in 2016 in words and pictures:

• Food Truck Fridays in cooperation with Edgewater Beach Apartments Coop,5555 N. Sheridan, brought a variety of food truck vendors every Friday evening from May to September. Edgewater's favorite Lickity Split also took up residence in the soda fountain to help populate the vacant space. Food Truck Fridays quickly became the place to hang, bringing together 450 customers each week from the neighborhood and beyond.

Food Truck Fridays even caught the attention of a group of Conventioneers visiting Chicago - 50 Pediatric Physicians from across the country enjoyed visiting Edgewater via 151 CTA Bus up Lake Shore Drive, indulged in Food Truck faire including popular desserts at Lickity Split in EBA's historic soda fountain, and a quick tour of the Historic Edgewater Beach Apartments. They later took over the patio at Little Mexican Café for drinks.









We also encouraged Food Truck Friday guests to check out the businesses on Bryn Mawr through cross promotions with Little Mexican Café, Subway,

Francescas and Nookies. The popular Chicago Paddle Board Company at Kathy Osterman Beach also participated in these cross-promotional offerings to attract other customers.









• Edgewater Development coordinated with **Remix Chicago** for a highly successful and popular **Pop-Up-Shop at 1052 W. Bryn Mawr** on weekends - Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday beginning in October and lasting through the end of December. It featured unique handmade and one-of-a-kind items – jewelry, artwork, photography, and accessories from 61 local vendors. 2,000 visitors enjoyed stocking up for the Holidays at this delightful store. • On April 27th Edgewater Uptown
Builders Association (EUBA) invited
Edgewater Development to make a
presentation on the latest trends in the

Broadway.

 On May 11th Edgewater Development convened its annual Dealmakers at Edgewater Beach Apartments in the Pool Conservatory. The event featured a presentation on Transit Oriented Development - the history and outline of benefits by Doug Farr, Farr & Associates. Jeffrey Wilson, CTA Director, Government & Community Relations spoke about

the Red & Purple Line Modernization. Over 60 attendees were then given a tour of the Edgewater landmark building celebrating its 100th Anniversary, or a commercial bus tour of North Edgewater Developments and Available Properties along Broadway-Devon-Clark-Ashland.











• Remix Chicago in cooperation with Edgewater Development held its 2nd Annual Holiday Market at Broadway Armory, 5917 N. Broadway on Saturday December 10. 85 vendors provided a terrific array of popular items with a focus on hand-crafted items created by local artists. The place was thronged with 1,700 visitors. SMACKDAB! sold their popular

donuts and coffee and Cookies and Carnitas offered soup and brisket chile along with their delicious cookies for the hungry shoppers.

• Overture Edgewater: Alderman Osterman requested that Greystar, as the developer of Overture, present the project to the neighboring community for their input. Edgewater

Development facilitated presentations and input at over 20 community meetings to stakeholders- Condo Associations, Association of Sheridan Road Condo Organization (ASCO) and Block Clubs, and Open Houses, over a 18-month period. The Developer, Greystar revised the project to reduce the height of the building from 18 stories to 16 and the number of units from 186 to 174. They also made aesthetic improvements to the façade of the parking structure. The final Community Meeting was held

on January 19th 2017 at St. Andrew Greek Orthodox Church at 5649 N. Sheridan Road, which was attended by 95 community residents, who voted overwhelmingly to support the project. **Alderman Osterman** believes the project will enhance the community with \$74 millon investment and bring new customers to support local businesses. Greystar will make applications to the City for a new Planned Development and file with Lakefront Protection through the Department of Planning and Development. Construction is expected to begin later in 2017 with opening in 2018.

Broadway** which opened in December with chef **Ryan Henderson**. Edgewater Development worked closely with Nelson through the community approval process. 
